

GLOBAL AGRIFOOD VC FUND OVERVIEW


The Fund will invest in approximately 100-200, seed to series A stage, AgriFood startups over a 5-year period in Australia, NZ, Asia & the Rest of the World and will:

- target >20% IRR
- be a 10-year duration fund (5-year investment period)
- have capacity for up to \$200M FUM from institutional, corporate & family office LPs looking for diversified AgriFood startup exposure & a pre-screened & derisked pipeline of later stage investments
- also have additional "specialised" FUM capacity for investors looking for bespoke agrifood exposure e.g. poultry, seafood, wine etc. (e.g. GRDC \$25M in GrainInnovate).
- draw down commitments in approximately equal amounts over the 5-year investment period of the Fund. The fund will invest approximately \$40-50M per year for 5 years.
- generally, take equity stakes in each of the startups but may also use other instruments such as convertible notes and venture debt.
- generally, Invest 15% of the Fund's capital at seed stage, 35% at angel to Series A and 50% to later stage follow-on rounds.

STAGE 1: SCOUTING

PRE-SCREENING

Artesian partners with a global network of agrifood related accelerators, incubators, university programs, angel groups and other ecosystem and industry participants to identify potential startup opportunities.

Artesian leverages this broad pipeline to pre-screen uninvestable opportunities and focus on the best 10% of new agrifood tech startups

GLOBAL AGTECH NETWORK

STAGE 2: SEED & ANGEL INVESTMENTS

SEED (15% of FUM)

The Fund invests a small amount in startups selected from the global network. The Fund receives pro rata rights to invest in subsequent rounds.

ANGEL (35% of FUM)

Co-invest with individual angels, angel groups and professional investors who provide external validation via investment, domain knowledge, board participation. Artesian reviews the syndicates due diligence

STAGE 3: LATER STAGE INVESTMENTS

LATER STAGE (50% of FUM)

Stock picking. Identification and investment in specific investee companies identified through Stage 2.

A portfolio of 50+ companies is selected by the team at Artesian to allocate larger amounts of capital.

LPs can leverage Artesian's investment process and due diligence to make larger, late stage direct investments
